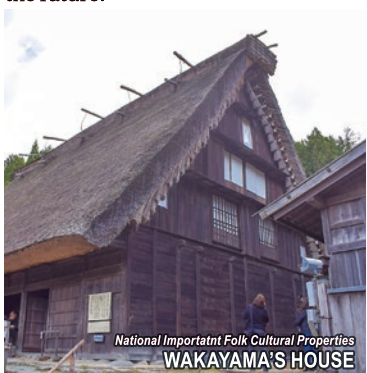
HIDA FOLK VILLAGE (HIDA NO SATO)

Hida no Sato is an outdoor museum with traditional houses, including four National Important Folk Cultural Assets moved and restored from different parts of Hida region.

Various kinds of tools and articles are displayed in each house, which makes it easy to imagine how life was in the old days, being preserved for the future.

May	Planting rice in "Kurumada" (wheel shaped rice paddy), Boys' Festival Celebration... "Washi Koinobori" (Carp Streamers)
Jun	Special Fire Drill for "Gassho" style houses, Iris Festival
Jul	Anniversary of the foundation of Hida no Sato- The showing of Takumi Shrine Ceiling Painting
Aug	"Tanabata" (Star Festival), children's activities for summer vacation
Sep	Rice harvest in "Kurumada" (wheel shaped paddy), "Mochi tsuki" (pounding of rice to make mochi rice cakes), distribution of mochi
